Privacy safeguards for the device



Whether your personal data leaves Australia



Whether the device is accessible for people with vision or auditory impairments



Additional safeguards to protect children's privacy



What types of personal information the IoT device collects



How long personal data is stored for and whether or how it can be deleted.



Whether the device is eco-friendly



Whether and how the device can be repaired, and the ongoing availability of software to make it work
