# Some problems with websites



- too much writing
- writing is too small



• you have to scroll or click too much



• different information on different pages



• hard to get help for questions or problems

on any extra charges



• write information in different colours



• write information in big size words



 see products side to side to make choices easier



- use plain language
- explain hard words

• offer lots of ways to get help

extra money you might have to pay on a plan



# human rights

the rights and freedoms that should happen for every person in the world



#### internet service

you pay for this so you can use the internet at home



#### live chat

a way to talk to a company by typing on the computer



**plan** is a **contract** you sign to agree to buy phone or internet



usually paid monthlyyou can ask to pay weekly or fortnightly

fortnightly is every 2 weeks



#### tablet

a flat, hand held device like

- iPad
- Samsung Galaxy
- Microsoft Surface
